VOLUNTEERS

UKRAINE



Since the war in Ukraine began in February 2022, IDES has been able to serve over 111,000 Ukrainians through our partnerships in Ukraine, Poland, Romania, and other nearby countries. IDES has provided over \$1.6 million in aid to 14 different mission partners who have helped evacuate Ukrainians, provide them with safe housing, transport food into occupied areas, provide medical care, and ultimately share the love of Christ.

Our work has varied throughout the duration of the war, as needs have changed and our partners find new ways to help. In the beginning of the war, IDES helped provide temporary housing to thousands of people as they evacuated from Ukraine and made their way to other countries. Now, IDES mission partners are housing over 600 refugees, with most of these people staying in apartments or similar set-ups meant to offer a long-term living solution to people who often do not have a home to return to.

IDES has continually provided food and other necessities to both safe zones and war-torn areas of Ukraine, where access to food has been severely restricted. Over the course of 2022, we estimate that IDES provided over 1.5 million pounds of food to Ukrainians in need.

Another way IDES has been serving the people of Ukraine is through providing our partners with vehicles to help with evacuation of people and delivery of necessary supplies. IDES purchased 8 large passenger vans that have collectively evacuated hundreds of Ukrainians and have been integral in distributing the 1.5 million pounds of food IDES has provided.

In 2022, IDES was able to send 11 shipping containers full of supplies to Ukraine, Poland, and Romania. 6 of these shipping containers were filled with our GAP meals, providing over 1,581,120 meals to Ukrainian refugees and IDPs. The remaining 5 containers were filled with various supplies, including medicines, various medical supplies, personal care items, blankets, and cold weather clothing. IDES partnered with churches and other organizations to fill these containers, which have been a huge blessing to our partners as they help Ukrainians.

Looking back over 2022, and even years before that, it's very evident that God has been involved in the work IDES is doing in Ukraine. Starting back in 2017, IDES worked with a partner in Ukraine to build 7 greenhouses to help make their work more self-sustaining.. We had no idea that years down the road, those very greenhouses would be used to grow food for people in occupied regions of Ukraine, where access to food became extremely scarce and military blockades sometimes prevented normal food transports from reaching the area.

Another example of God's providence in the midst of this war involves a well project that IDES started back in 2020. Due to some project delays and changes of location, IDES ended up drilling a well in the city of Mariupol in 2021, which at the time seemed like an odd location for a well. However, once Mariupol was heavily shelled by Russia and water lines were destroyed, it became clear that God had planned this well very specifically. The well, on the grounds of a church, was one of the only remaining water sources in the city. Our partner for the project reported that hundreds of lives were saved because they were able to get water from the well that IDES had helped drill.

We know our work in Ukraine is far from over. We pray the war ends soon, but IDES is committed to providing help and hope in Ukraine long-term. Please join us in praying for an end to the war and that even through tragedy, God would be glorified and people would come to know Him.

The Beginning...

1970: Following a major cyclone that hit Bangladesh, Milton Bates, and his wife, Janet, were deeply moved by the utter destruction they saw on the news reports. Burdened to help somehow, Milton and Janet prayed for God to reveal a way to unite the brotherhood of independent Christian Churches/Churches of Christ in a significant relief effort. After writing and sending over 500 letters from their own kitchen table to various Christian leaders, 9 men wrote back that they would support Milton if he volunteered to lead the effort. Faithfully, Milton and Janet continued to pray for direction, and for the missionaries they were connected with around the world.

Then, at the 1973 North American Christian Convention, Milton and these 9 leaders met together for the first time, and International Disaster Emergency Service was officially created.

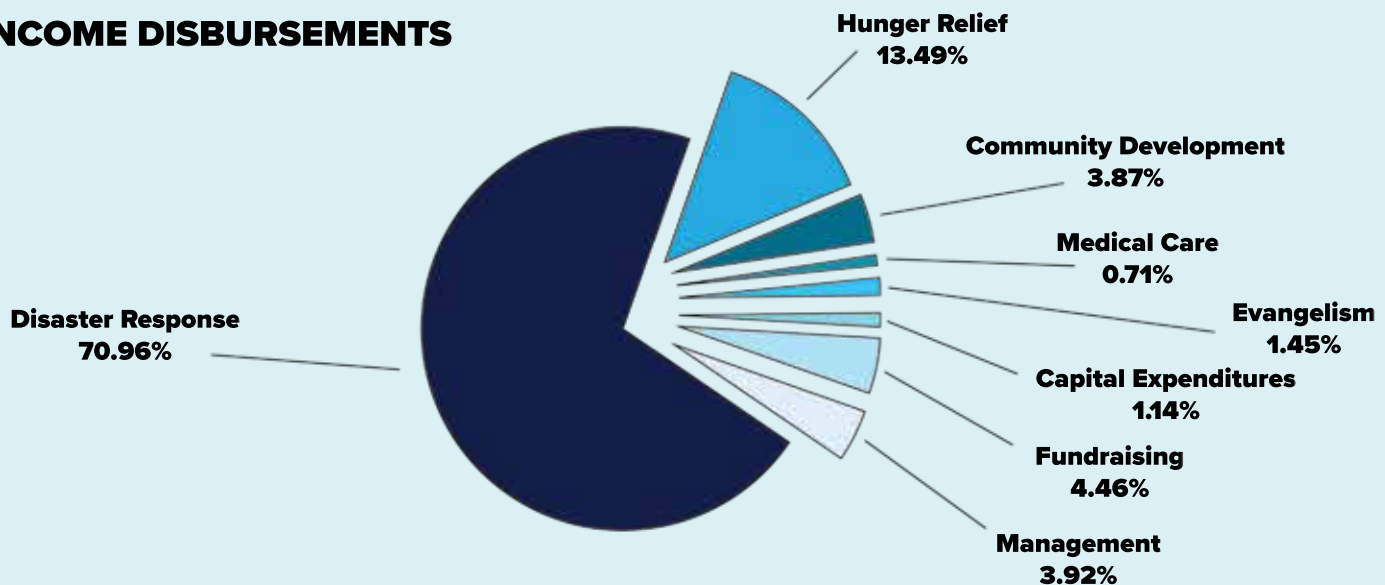
