QUESTIONS TO ASK ABOUT SHEDS FOR HOST CHURCHES

These questions will help identify areas to make the delivery, and the assembly, of the sheds go smoothly.

- Is the drop off location adequate for unloading a semi-truck?
- Is there enough space to maneuver the truck, and off-load the sheds from the side?
- Is there enough space to store the sheds until they are taken to the final location?
- Is the location secured?
- Is the location accessible weekdays and weekends?
- Is a full list of recipients of the sheds available, including their full contact information?
- Has someone visited each individual property where the sheds will be built?
- Does that location have power?
- How level is the area?
- Is there a location for the materials to be placed, one that is out of the way, yet handy to the build location?
- Has it been confirmed that the tools needed are available?
- If some of the tools are not available, has the IDES team been notified, so they can provide them?
- Are the right nails for the pneumatic tools available?
- Are the right loose nails available?
- Have miscellaneous items that are not sent on the semi, been sent separately?
 - These may be ratchet straps, unloading slings, blocks, shims?
- Has it been verified that:
 - the shed will meet zoning requirements?
 - the shed will meet area building requirements?
 - all the necessary building permits have been obtained?
 - this includes home owner association approval.
- Are there shower facilities for volunteers?
 - Consider portable shower trailers, rentals
