Medical care is costly in America, but non-existent in many countries, at least for the poor. IDES provides mosquito nets to help prevent malaria, a chief killer worldwide. Medical Clinics help meet the needs of the sick. Doctors volunteer their time, but they need medicines to treat their patients. Many evangelists receive a medical kit and training to become traveling caregivers for the more basic ailments they encounter.

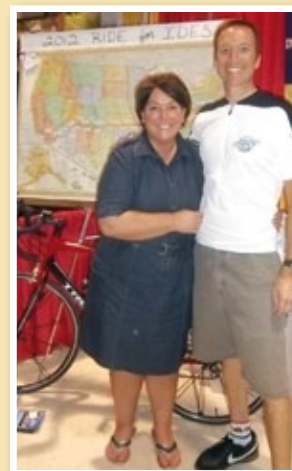
