Near & Far

This year, IDES has been more active than ever with projects from each of our five Focus Areas in locations near and far. As I write this, we have already been involved in over 100 projects in 43 countries. Some of these projects include: a leadership conference in Zimbabwe through IDES' Evangelism and Discipleship focus, Medical Care in South Sudan, Hunger Relief in Kenya, clean water wells in Niger as part of our Community Development efforts, and major Disaster Response from the US to Ukraine.

In all of these efforts, both near and far, you have partnered with us to meet essential physical needs and open the door to life-changing spiritual transformation. We've seen time and again that when individuals have their physical needs met, they are more open and receptive to having their spiritual needs met. In fact, recently while delivering supplies to a homeowner in Ohio whose home suffered tornado damage, IDES US Disaster Coordinator was asked how to get plugged-in to the local church!

It is truly an honor to serve the Lord by providing Help and Hope. Last month I was in Kentucky to be part of a home dedication for one of the families who lost their residence in the tornadoes that ravaged several communities at the end of 2021. IDES has been there from the beginning, providing guidance, leading incredible volunteers in cleanup efforts, and now rebuilding homes that were destroyed, giving families a new sense of hope.

Two weeks ago, I traveled to Ukraine, Poland, and Romania to visit IDES' relief projects. IDES has been part of ongoing relief efforts since the first days of Russia's invasion. We have coordinated with our partners to provide immediate evacuations and food, as well as to secure housing and supplies for thousands of refugees and Internally Displaced People. IDES continues to support refugees at multiple locations and ensure food and supplies are delivered to families in Russian-occupied Ukraine.

Thank YOU for partnering with us to meet the physical and spiritual needs of suffering people all around the world in the name of Jesus Christ!

Kansas, Kentucky, Ohio, Honduras, Poland, Ukraine, India, Kenya, Pakistan, Afghanistan—the list of locations where IDES has active projects goes on and on. As long as there is a need, IDES will be there sharing immediate Help and eternal Hope with those both near and far.

In 2022 alone, IDES has been able to rebuild 17 homes in Haiti following the devastating earthquake last year.



More than 5,311 people have already volunteered with IDES this year, assisting with food packing, office work, remodeling, disaster site relief and so much more!

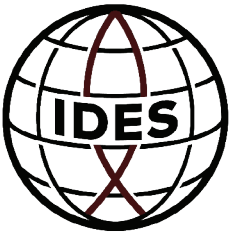
