There is an African proverb which says 'Empty bellies have no ears.' If we are to share the Gospel, we also need to meet the physical needs of those we are sharing our hope with. 
Cleft Lip/Palate Surgery \$300

Our team of 10 people including 3 surgeons and 1 anesthesiologist from our hospital were able to perform 34 major surgeries on cleft lip and palate, 25 minor procedures and 3 burn grafts surgeries. These surgical camps are able to provide life-saving surgeries, food and care for the patient/family, and food for the doctors, nurses, technicians, and others who helped with the surgical camp. We have our leaders and evangelists do the follow up work with patients, their parents, and relatives to give way to the extension of the Kingdom.







US Disaster Response efforts initiated following hurricanes Katrina & Rita


