<p>Over 2,000 villagers from northern Myanmar have escaped from battle grounds leaving behind their homes, animals, rice barns and fields. Some have stepped on land mines in leaving and lost limbs or died. The number of refugees are increasing as the fighting continues. IDES sent funds to missionaries in the area to purchase rice and beans. These missionaries, along with local evangelists, distributed the food to the refugees and shared with them that the help came from Christians on the other side of the world who wanted to share the love of Christ and meet their needs.
